The beginning of adolescence marks the beginning of dramatic changes. Students at this age, though young and inexperienced, are in the process of putting childhood behind them. They often feel self-conscious and unready for adult responsibilities, but they yearn, nevertheless, to be mature.

We recognize the traits of this period of transition and address them in the design of our Middle School. From the start of sixth grade, to eighth grade graduation, students are guided, encouraged, and challenged toward becoming young adults.

During these three years, students will advance from self-contained classrooms to rotated scheduling and greater academic demands. Emphasis is placed on acquiring the skills necessary to work capably as independent learners. Students learn how to study, budget their time, prepare for a test, plan a project, and work in a group. Our focus is on preparing our students for both the academic challenge of high school and the challenge of making life decisions.

Our Middle School students are held to high standards of behavior. We stress personal responsibility for actions and actively reinforce character development. We expect students to be active partners in their learning, giving their best effort toward developing a strong academic background that enables them to use, to the fullest, their God-giving potential.

The curriculum provides a challenging academic program that integrates the Christian faith with the learning process in each classroom and in each activity. Student life and learning are rooted in the richness of knowing that God loves them and understands them and that they belong to Him.

Current Course Offerings for Grades 6-8

Bible Instruction

One of the defining characteristics of GCS is that Biblical principles are integrated into all classes and the entire educational experience. Middle School Bible Courses, led by our Senior and Children's pastors, include Old Testament Studies, comparative World Religions, and New Testament Studies. We also have weekly chapel with students with guest speakers leading the program.

English

Students use an integrated approach to study grammar, writing, literature, and vocabulary each year. Writing instruction and standards are in place across all academic subjects in the Middle School curriculum. Independent reading is required at each grade level. Through study of contemporary and classical literature, students will analyze how literature and the world influence one another.



Mathematics

Math classes include General Math, Pre-Algebra, Algebra 1 and Geometry. Sixth grade Pre-Algebra and General Math continue mathematical thinking and practical application of math concepts and facts. Seventh grade math emphasizes Pre-Algebra or Algebra 1 preparation. 8th grade Algebra and/or Geometry is a high school level course for which students may receive high school credit upon successful completion of the course.

Science

Middle School science classes include: Biology & Environment, Life Science (Anatomy and Physiology), and Physical Science. Instruction is highly interactive with labs and activities to reinforce learning.

History & Social Studies

Students take Ancient World History, U.S. History, and Government Civics. Emphasis is placed on the importance of historical thinking and understanding. Geography, economics, and governing concepts are woven through each course.

Physical Education

Middle School students take physical education each year. Skill building, health, and lifetime fitness & activity are highlighted.

Spanish

Middle School students take introductory Spanish in grade 6, Spanish 1 is taken over two years in grades 7 and 8. Students who excel may qualify for high school credit.

Technology

Students receive technology training each year. Students are instructed using Microsoft Office, Google apps, iPads, and media production. Instruction is connected with the classroom projects.

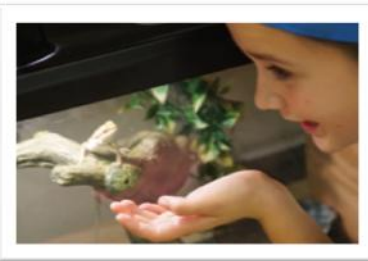

Music
