Dear Prospective GCS Parent,

Preschool

Our educators recognize the importance of both indoor and outdoor learning environments. They create a rich atmosphere filled with safe stimuli tailored to each student's needs. A range of ageappropriate opportunities helps children master skills and concepts, with classroom resources selected to reflect a biblical worldview. We offer flexible options to fit your family's needs with full-day preschool classes available for

2 days, 3 days, or 5 days each week.

Elementary

Our curriculum provides a cohesive learning experience based on a Christian worldview. Teachers support skill development while fostering students' natural curiosity. With a structured program that builds in complexity, students graduate from elementary school well-prepared and confident for middle school.

Middle

Adolescence brings significant changes as students transition from childhood. Though they may feel self-conscious and unprepared for adult responsibilities, they seek maturity. We acknowledge these traits in our middle school design, guiding and encouraging students from sixth grade to eighth grade graduation to become Godly young adults committed to growing in their faith.





ABOUT EKKLESIA

One of the most special aspects of our school is Ekklesia. Tuition Payment Options

- Annual Payment Due in full by July 1, 2025, or within 10 days of enrollment.
- Monthly Payments Payments made through FACTS beginning July 2025, through June 2026.

Tuition Reductions

• East Side Grace attendees – 10% (if the family regularly attends ESGBC and is actively involved in a church ministry program and financially supporting the church on a regular basis.).

Scholarship Opportunities (Kindergarten - 8th Grade)

• EdChoice Scholarship Program – All families are encouraged to apply and will benefit based on either adjusted gross income (EdChoice Expansion Scholarship) or residency (Traditional EdChoice). Go to Ohio Department of Education for complete details.

*Please note that the EdChoice scholarship does not cover the entire tuition amount and families will be responsible for any remaining tuition unless they qualify for low-income status. Families will also be required to pay other fees throughout the school year.

Ohio Christian Education Scholarship Granting Organization (OCEN SGO) Scholarship
 Students with a demonstrated need are prioritized. Go to OCEN SGO for complete details.

Admissions-Related Fees (non-refundable)

- New Student Application Fee \$190 per student; due at the time the application for admission is submitted.
- Returning Student Re-enrollment Fee \$145 per student if enrollment is completed by January 19, 2025; \$190 per student if enrollment is completed after January 19, 2025.

Extended Care

Extended care is offered before school from 7:15–8:15am and after school from the end of dismissal (3:30pm) until 5:30pm. The cost is \$6.50 per hour. There is a late fee of \$1 per minute after 5:30.

EdChoice Scholarship

EdChoice Expansion Scholarship (all students grades K-12 eligible to apply)

- Allows for students who are not assigned to an EdChoice designated public school building to receive a scholarship.
- Scholarship award based on family's household Adjusted Gross Income (line 11 of Federal Tax Return 1040).
- Scholarships ranged from \$616.60 to \$6,166.00 for the 2024-2025 school year.

Traditional EdChoice Scholarship (eligibility requirements exist)

- Students enrolled at GCS who would otherwise be assigned to an EdChoice (low performing) designated public school building are eligible.
- Maximum amount of scholarship awarded (\$6,166 for the 2024-2025 school year).

How to apply for the EdChoice Scholarship:

Step 1: Apply to Grace Christian School. A student must be enrolled at a private school before applying.

Step 2: If your student is admitted as a student to GCS, you will complete the EdChoice Scholarship Request Form and submit it to GCS along with supporting documents.

Step 3: Verify your income with the State of Ohio (if applying for the EdChoice Expansion Scholarship or applying for low-income status).

Who can apply for the EdChoice Scholarship?

All families with students in grades kindergarten through 12th grade can apply, except students who already receive a scholarship such as the Autism Scholarship or Jon Peterson Scholarship.

Preschool students are not eligible.

Will we have out-of-pocket tuition?

Families at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level qualify for low-income status. The law states that low-income families are not required to pay any remaining tuition balance. Those above 200% will be billed for the remaining tuition balance after the scholarship is applied to your account. All families, regardless of income status, are responsible for other fees (see Tuition and Fee Schedule). Families may also apply for additional assistance with the Ohio Christian Education Network Scholarship Granting Organization.
